Real-life Cinderella story New adoptive parents say it was "love at first sight"

Priscilla's Cinderella story is similar in some ways to the Disney character's, but times have changed and there's a new narrative for orphans in our society. The happiest part of Priscilla's narrative began right here at Southeastern Children's Home.

The youngest of three children, Priscilla was removed from her childhood home due to parental neglect, and then lived in a series of foster homes. But the

protections afforded birth parents and the many other legal hurdles involved can cause the termination of parental rights to take years.

This is why Priscilla was a teenager by the time the SC courts terminated the parental rights of her birth parents, and at that point, in the eyes of our legal system, she had no parents at all. She had become an example of what's sometimes referred to as a "modern-day orphan."

There are few families willing to adopt

teenagers in Priscilla's situation, so for a myriad of reasons, those in foster care are rarely adopted. Typically, they exit the foster system only when they turn 18 and become "adults."

"Most of the time, children placed with us are angry," said Southeastern Children's Home caseworker Ashely Remick. "Priscilla wasn't angry. She didn't have defiant tendencies. She was an optimist. She always saw the best in people."

Priscilla spent much of her time at Southeastern developing close relationships with our staff and co-residents. She excelled in school and consistently earned A's and B's on her report card. Yet, despite her upbeat attitude and stellar performance in and out of the classroom, there were no families willing to adopt this amazing 17-year-old girl.

Her story took an unexpected turn, however, when Priscilla volunteered to help out with one of Southeastern's yard sales several months ago. It was on that fateful day that one of our volunteer families, the Johnstons, met Priscilla.

"I guess you could say it was love at first sight," said Trevor Johnston. "We struck up a conversation with Priscilla as she was selling cookies at the yard sale. We really felt the Lord
