

Negative behaviors and tears almost always surface during this time of year, and our staff prays for guidance as they seek to buffer and comfort all involved. This past Christmas season was

This past Christmas season was an exception, however, perhaps because Southeastern was celebrating 50 years and jubilation was in the air. Or perhaps it was the generosity of our donors. Lear, for example, took residents shopping for shoes and clothes, spending one-on-one time with each child, making them feel special and important. Being able to buy name brands worn by other students at school reminds these children that they're valuable members of society.

Another donor, DraexImaier, helped us teach our residents the art of giving, taking them to buy loved ones gifts they otherwise wouldn't have been able to afford. The moment the children returned home, they asked to wrap the gifts, because they were so excited to have something to give brothers, sisters, cousins and grandparents.

Had you been with us inside the resident cottages on Christmas morning, here's what you'd have seen ...

Unexpected joy

Wearing the warm pajamas they'd received the night before, the children sat opening gifts beneath the tree while the rest of the family watched and enjoyed.

A few hours later, only one gift remained and it was for Mary. She was so grateful

for what she'd received already and was overwhelmed by the prospect of yet another gift for her to open. Eyes wide, she tore into the colorful paper and at the first glimpse of what was inside, she set it down, covered her face with her hands and cried. Her house mom sat beside her and

asked, "Are you okay, Mary? Is something wrong?" and the room was so quiet you could have heard a pin drop. Then Mary looked up with a big, timid smile and said, "I put this on my list, but there's no way I expected to get it".

Wearable Joy

Johnny came to Southeastern with nothing but the clothes on his back, and although 16 years old, this past Christmas was the first one he'd ever celebrated. He'd never had a Christmas with gifts or a table filled with holiday food. Making a Christmas list was new to him, too, but he did it anyway. One item on his list was a Carhart

jacket, something he said he'd always wanted, and when he found that jacket inside a box on Christmas morning, his face lit up like the brightest lights on the tree.

We feel so grateful to have shared these moments, and many others, with our precious children. And while only two of the donors are highlighted here, we all know it takes many more wonderful people – people like you – to make the holidays happen for these children in a way that brings happiness into their lives.
